Good news! The Last Wilderness Conservation Association has approved the formation of a new committee: the Last Wilderness Watershed Committee. The purpose of this committee is to provide community education and oversight on all matters that affect the lakes, rivers, wetlands and the lands surrounding these areas in Presque Isle.

While Lake Associations have been instrumental in educating lake property owners and protecting individual lakes, no organization in Presque Isle has overseen the interests of all the water bodies in our township. The Last Wilderness Watershed Committee will promote best stewardship practices by hosting outstanding speakers and workshops on a variety of watershed issues. Another objective is to ensure that all aspects of development, from real estate transactions to zoning and construction take place within the rules, laws and ordinances set forth.
