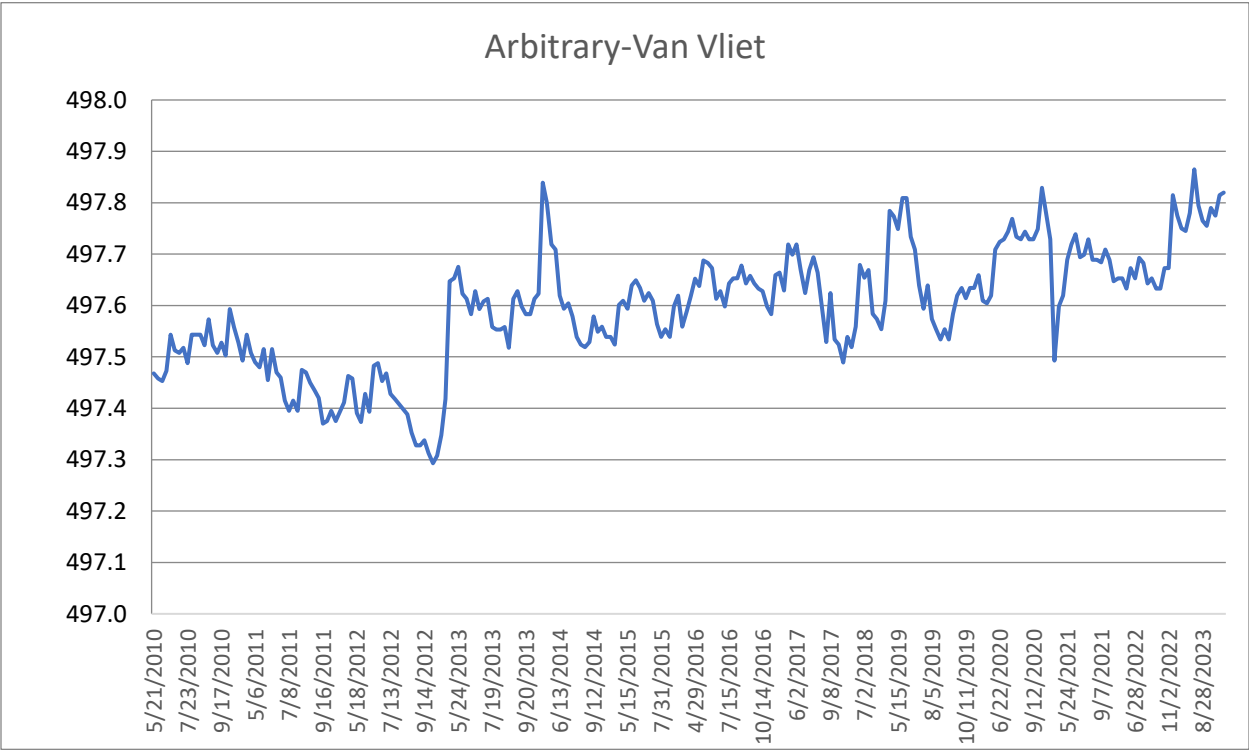
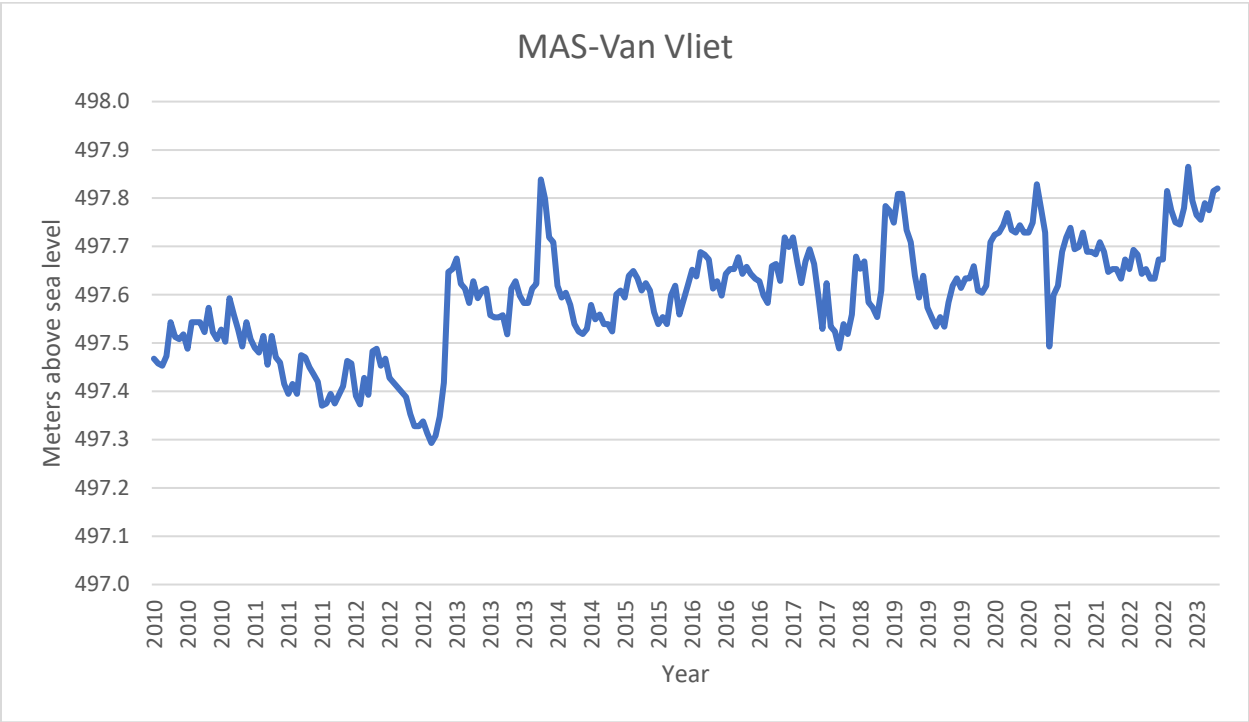

Interpreting the data in the graphs provided: An **arbitrary water level** value is a general measure of the height of a body of water. This measure can be taken from any point and is usually relative to the surrounding land, in this case, the lag bolt. Meters above sea level (**MAS**) is a measure of elevation or altitude. It is an exact measure based on the distance between the surface of the water and the mean sea level. This measure is used to determine height above sea level or the depth of a body of water.
